


What to do when a Hurricane threatens...

If you are in ZONE A, plan to evacuate for ALL hurricanes.
 If you are in ZONE B, plan to evacuate for Category 3, 4 or 5 storms.
 If you are in ZONE C, plan to evacuate for a Category 4 or 5 hurricane.

If you live near an evacuation zone boundary and are unsure of the evacuation zone you are in, error on the side of caution and assume you are in the zone nearest to the coast. If you live in a mobile home in any of the three evacuation zones, plan to evacuate any time a hurricane threatens.

The main evacuation routes are highlighted in blue. These routes will take you out of the area of immediate danger. When a hurricane threatens, listen for instructions from local officials on how and when to evacuate.

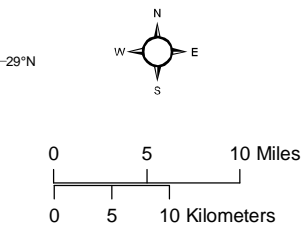


HURRICANE EVACUATION
